## ScanWorkX for D365: New UI Options

In this month's edition of the ScanWorkX newsletter we will be discussing the new CSS and Images files available on our website for

download at <a href="https://scanworkx.com/themes/">https://scanworkx.com/themes/</a>. The new folders will replace the existing CSS and Images folder, when applied and coupled with existing theme changes in D365, they will give the ScanWorkX UI a more modern look and feel.

#### Downloading and Applying Folders and Themes

After navigating to the ScanWorkX Themes webpage, you will notice that there are currently two designs available for download, these two styles are 'Modern Dark' and 'Sky Blue'. Example screenshots of these designs can be viewed on the Themes webpage linked above.



If you decide you like one of the available designs, you will need to click 'Download', input your email address, and then click 'Send link'. You will need to do this for both the CSS and Images folders, as both are required to apply the full design change.





If you would like detailed instructions on how to replace the existing CSS and Images folders, click on the 'View Instructions' button. Basically, you will need to log-on to the server hosting ScanWorkX, then you will navigate to c:/inetpub/wwwroot/ScanWorkX and replace the existing CSS and Images folders.




The last step to finalizing the design to match the design showed on the screenshots is to create a new Theme within D365. You can navigate to the form holding theme information via DSI ScanWorkX – Handheld Setup – Device Settings. This table pictured above can be found directly below the 'Sky Blue' CSS and Images download section. A different table exists underneath the 'Modern Dark' theme.






Once you have entered the form, click 'Create', specify a name for the new theme, in my case I am copying the 'Sky Blue' theme so I will name it as such. Once you have specified a name, click 'Ok'.





Filter the 'Theme/Device Type' column to show only the theme you have just created, match up the values here to the table pictured above/displayed on the ScanWorkX themes webpage.




Another option is to import directly into the Device Settings table via the built in Import/Export tool within D365. At the bottom of the themes webpage, you will find the quick import instructions and download link.



#### \*\*\*\*\*DISCLAIMER\*\*\*\*

The file will overwrite any existing Themes/Device Settings you may have created, so only use this option if you are okay with deleting your existing custom themes, or if you do not have any custom themes, as this will come with the default 'HTML5' theme.



You will import the spreadsheet via the Import/Export Log, you can get here via DSI ScanWorkX – Administration – Import/Export Log. Click 'Import', select only 'Device Settings', and then click 'Ok' after loading in the 'Themes' XIsx file.
